Facility Association Application for an Increase in Automobile Insurance Rates for Taxis and Limousines

On March 17, 2016 Facility Association (Facility) filed an application with the Newfoundland and Labrador Board of Commissioners of Public Utilities seeking approval of increased automobile insurance rates on a territory basis for its Taxi and Limousine class of business, to be effective on October 1, 2016.

As a result of the previous applications, Facility's rates for Taxi and Limousine automobile insurance increased by an average of 50.1% on August 1, 2013, 19.3% on September 1, 2015, and 28.9% on June 1, 2016.
