1 **IN THE MATTER OF** the *Automobile*

6 **IN THE MATTER OF** an application by
7 The Dominion of Canada General Insurance
8 Company for approval to implement revised
9 rates for its Private Passenger Automobiles
10 class of business.

13 **WHEREAS** on October 11, 2017 The Dominion of Canada General Insurance Company applied
14 to the Board for approval of a revised rating program for its Newfoundland and Labrador Private
15 Passenger Automobiles class of business in accordance with Order No. A.I. 17(2017); and

17 **WHEREAS** on October 11, 2017 the Board’s actuarial consultants, Oliver Wyman Limited,
18 confirmed that the revised rating program complies with the parameters specified in Order No.
19 A.I. 17(2017); and

21 **WHEREAS** the Board is satisfied that the proposed rates are not too high in the circumstances.

24 **IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:**

- 26 1. The revised rating program received October 11, 2017 from The Dominion of Canada General
27 Insurance Company for its Newfoundland and Labrador Private Passenger Automobiles class
28 of business is approved to be effective no sooner than January 1, 2018 for new business and
29 February 1, 2018 for renewals.

- 31 2. The Dominion of Canada General Insurance Company will be required to pay the costs of the
32 Board associated with this filing, including the costs of the actuarial review.


