1 **IN THE MATTER OF** the *Automobile*  
2 *Insurance Act*, RSNL 1990, c. A-22, (the  
3 “*Act*”), as amended and regulations  
4 thereunder; and  
5

6 **IN THE MATTER OF** an application  
7 by The Dominion of Canada General  
8 Insurance Company for approval to  
9 implement a revised rating program  
10 for its Buses class of business.

13 **WHEREAS** on September 18, 2017 The Dominion of Canada General Insurance Company  
14 (“Dominion”) applied to the Board for approval of a revised automobile insurance rating program  
15 for its Buses class of business; and  
16

17 **WHEREAS** the application proposed to adopt IAO advisory rates for some coverages and  
18 proposed a revised algorithm for calculating rates for other coverages; and  
19

20 **WHEREAS** Dominion’s experience for its Buses class of business is insufficient to provide an  
21 actuarially justified rate filing; and  
22

23 **WHEREAS** the Board is satisfied that the IAO advisory rates are acceptable for use by Dominion  
24 in the circumstances; and  
25

26 **WHEREAS** the Board is satisfied that the proposed rates are not too high in the circumstances.


29 **IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:**

33 sooner than January 1, 2018 for new business and renewals.


