20	WHEREAS Dominion's experience for its Buses class of business is insufficient to provide an
21	actuarially justified rate filing; and

23	WHEREAS the Board is satisfied that the IAO advisory rates are acceptable for use by Dominion
24	in the circumstances; and

26	WHEREAS the Board is satisfied that the proposed rates are not too high in the circumstances.
