1 **IN THE MATTER OF** the *Automobile*  
2 *Insurance Act*, RSNL 1990, c. A-22, (the  
3 “*Act*”), as amended and regulations  
4 thereunder; and

6 **IN THE MATTER OF** an application  
7 by The Dominion of Canada General  
8 Insurance Company for approval to  
9 implement a revised rating program for  
10 its Funeral Carriages class of business.

13 **WHEREAS** on September 18, 2017 The Dominion of Canada General Insurance Company  
14 (“Dominion”) applied to the Board for approval of a revised automobile insurance rating program  
15 for its Funeral Carriages class of business; and  
16

17 **WHEREAS** the application proposed a revised algorithm for calculating rates for its Funeral  
18 Carriages class of business; and  
19

20 **WHEREAS** Dominion’s experience for its Funeral Carriages class of business is insufficient to  
21 provide an actuarially justified rate filing; and

23 **WHEREAS** the Board is satisfied that the proposed rates are not too high in the circumstances.


26 **IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:**

- 28 1. The revised rating program received September 18, 2017 from The Dominion of Canada  
29 General Insurance Company for its Funeral Carriages class of business is approved to be  
30 effective no sooner than January 1, 2018 for new business and renewals.
