7 by The Dominion of Canada General
8 Insurance Company for approval of
9 revised rates for its Private Passenger
10 Automobiles class of business.

13 **WHEREAS** on October 16, 2018 The Dominion of Canada General Insurance Company applied
14 for approval of a revised rating program for its Private Passenger Automobiles class of business in
15 accordance with Order No. A.I. 34(2018); and

17 **WHEREAS** on October 19, 2018 The Dominion of Canada General Insurance Company filed an
18 amendment to its revised rating program; and

20 **WHEREAS** on October 19, 2018 the Board’s actuarial consultants, Oliver Wyman Limited,
21 reported that the proposed rates in The Dominion of Canada General Insurance Company’s
22 amended filing complied with the parameters specified in Order No. A.I. 34(2018); and

24 **WHEREAS** the Board is satisfied that the proposed rates are not too high in the circumstances.


27 **IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:**

- 29 1. The revised rating program received October 16, 2018, amended October 19, 2018, from The
30 Dominion of Canada General Insurance Company for its Private Passenger Automobiles class
31 of business is approved to be effective no sooner than January 2, 2019 for new business and
32 February 1, 2019 for renewals.

34 2. The Dominion of Canada General Insurance Company will pay all costs of the Board,
35 including the cost of the actuarial review, arising from this Application.
