13 WHEREAS on September 15, 2020 CUMIS General Insurance Company ("CUMIS") applied to 14 the Board for approval of a revised rating program under the Mandatory Simplified filing option 15 for its Camping and Utility Trailers class of automobile insurance, effective March 1, 2021 for 16 new business and renewals; and

- 18 WHEREAS CUMIS does not have sufficient volume to perform an actuarial analysis for Camping 19 and Utility Trailers and proposed to adopt the rates and algorithms of Co-operators General 20 Insurance Company ("CGIC"); and

22 WHEREAS CUMIS and CGIC are both members of The Co-operators group of companies; and 23

24 WHEREAS CUMIS noted that adopting CGIC rates would allow it to continue to offer clients 25 appropriate rates and to benefit from the advantages of the group of companies; and

27 WHEREAS the Board finds that the proposal is made in accordance with the Board's Mandatory 28 Simplified Filing Guidelines and is supported; and

- 30 WHEREAS the Board is satisfied that the proposed rates are just and reasonable in the 31 circumstances, do not impair the solvency of the insurer, are not excessive in relation to the 32 financial circumstances of the insurer, and do not violate the Automobile Insurance Act or the
- 33 Insurance Companies Act or the respective regulations thereunder.
