19	issue in its summary table of premiums; and

21	WHEREAS CUMIS proposed various changes to its SEF43R and SEF43R(L) endorsement offerings;

24	WHEREAS CUMIS also proposed to discontinue offering its Physical Damage Extension
25	Endorsement Packages, PDE1 and PDE1A; and

27	WHEREAS there will be no impact on current business related to this filing, as clients that
28	currently have any of the effected endorsement offerings will be grandfathered; and

30	WHEREAS the revised rating program is filed in accordance with the Supplemental Filing
31	Guidelines; and

WHEREAS the Board is satisfied that the proposed rates are just and reasonable in the circumstances, do not impair the solvency of the insurer, are not excessive in relation to the financial circumstances of the insurer, and do not violate the Automobile Insurance Act or the Insurance Companies Act or the respective regulations thereunder.
