16	WHEREAS the proposed rule changes are generally administrative in nature and are part of an
17	effort by Facility Association to simplify, streamline and harmonize rules across all jurisdictions in
18	which it operates; and

20	WHEREAS the proposal is filed in accordance with the Supplemental Filing Guidelines; and

22	WHEREAS the Board is satisfied that the proposed changes are just and reasonable in the
23	circumstances, do not impair the solvency of the insurer, are not excessive in relation to the
24	financial circumstances of the insurer, and do not violate the <b>Automobile Insurance Act</b> or the
25	Insurance Companies Act or the respective regulations thereunder.

28	IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:

30	1. The proposal received November 1, 2023 from Facility Association for approval to implement
31	rule changes is approved to be effective no sooner than April 1, 2024 for new business and
