13 Supplemental filing option for approval of rule changes applicable to its various lines of business;

17 **WHEREAS** the proposed rule changes are generally administrative in nature and are part of an
18 effort by Facility Association to simplify, streamline and harmonize rules across all jurisdictions in
19 which it operates; and

22 **WHEREAS** the proposal is filed in accordance with the Supplemental Filing Guidelines; and

25 **WHEREAS** the Board is satisfied that the proposed changes are just and reasonable in the
26 circumstances, do not impair the solvency of the insurer, are not excessive in relation to the
27 financial circumstances of the insurer, and do not violate the **Automobile Insurance Act** or the
28 **Insurance Companies Act** or the respective regulations thereunder.



32 **IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:**



1. The proposal received November 1, 2023 from Facility Association for approval to implement rule changes is approved to be effective no sooner than April 1, 2024 for new business and renewals.


