14 **WHEREAS** on March 7, 2025 Co-operators General Insurance Company (“Co-operators”) applied
15 to the Board under the Supplemental filing option for approval to introduce endorsements for its
16 Motorcycles and Mopeds type of Miscellaneous Vehicles automobile insurance; and

18 **WHEREAS** Co-operators proposed to offer two new optional endorsements for Motorcycles and
19 Mopeds, to enhance its product offering and better meet the needs of insureds; and

21 **WHEREAS** there is no rate level impact associated with this change; and


23 **WHEREAS** the proposal is filed in accordance with the Supplemental Filing Guidelines; and

25 **WHEREAS** the Board is satisfied that the proposed changes are just and reasonable in the
26 circumstances, do not impair the solvency of the insurer, are not excessive in relation to the
27 financial circumstances of the insurer, and do not violate the **Automobile Insurance Act** or the
28 **Insurance Companies Act** or the respective regulations thereunder.


31 **IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:**

- 33 1. The proposal received March 7, 2025 from Co-operators General Insurance Company to
34 introduce endorsements for its Motorcycles and Mopeds type of Miscellaneous Vehicles
35 automobile insurance is approved to be effective no sooner than September 3, 2025 for new
36 business and October 3, 2025 for renewals.
