

Invitation to Participate

The Public Utilities Board is conducting a review of issues related to the regulation of petroleum products pricing in the province, including the schedule and process for maximum price adjustments, extraordinary adjustments, benchmark prices, mark-ups and zone differentials. This review is being conducted in three phases. Phase I will identify the specific issues to be addressed in Phases II and III of the review.

As part of Phase I the Board has released a Consultation Document setting out information related to petroleum products pricing regulation and the issues to be addressed in this review. The expert engaged to assist the Board in this review, Kalibrate Canada Inc, has also completed a report as part of Phase I. These reports and other information about the review, including the work plan and schedule, can be found on the Board's website.

The Board is now inviting participation in Phase I of the review. Further opportunities for participation, including making a presentation, will be provided in Phases II and III of the review. Interested persons can provide their views as to the issues to be addressed by Friday, February 10, 2023.
