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12 **WHEREAS** in Order No. P.P. 99(2022) the Board approved a temporary increase in the retail  
13 portion of the total allowed mark-up to be reflected in the maximum retail prices for gasoline  
14 motor fuel in Zones 10, 11, 11a, 11b, 12 and 14 until further order of the Board; and  
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16 **WHEREAS** based on available information, the Board is satisfied that it is reasonable to  
17 discontinue the temporary increase to the retail portion of the total allowed mark-up included in  
18 gasoline motor fuel in Zones 10, 11, 11a, 11b, 12 and 14 approved in Order No. P.P. 99(2022);

22 prices which can be charged for this product in these zones effective 12:01 a.m., Thursday,

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
- 28 1. The temporary increase to the retail portion of the total allowed mark-up for gasoline
