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6 **IN THE MATTER OF** the suspension
7 of maximum price adjustments for
8 gasoline and diesel motor fuels and
9 stove oil heating fuel in Zone 12.

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12 **WHEREAS** Order No. P.P. 51(2021) suspended maximum price adjustments for gasoline and
13 diesel motor fuels and stove oil heating fuel in Zones 10, 11, 11a, 11b, 12 and 14, effective
14 November 25, 2021; and

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16 **WHEREAS** Order No. P.P. 38(2022) lifted the suspension of maximum price adjustments for
17 gasoline and diesel motor fuels and stove oil heating fuel in Zones 10, 11 and 11b effective May
18 26, 2022; and

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20 **WHEREAS** based on delivery information provided to the Board by suppliers to the region the
21 spring resupply of gasoline and diesel motor fuels and stove oil heating fuel to Zone 12 and has
22 commenced; and

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24 **WHEREAS** the Board is satisfied that the seasonal suspension of maximum price adjustments
25 should be lifted for gasoline and diesel motor fuels and stove oil heating fuel in Zone 12.

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28 **IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT**


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- 30 1. The suspension of maximum price adjustments for gasoline and diesel motor fuels and
