1 **IN THE MATTER OF the Petroleum Products**

2 **Act**, SNL 2001, Chapter P-10.1 and  
3 regulations thereunder; and

5 **IN THE MATTER OF** an alternative pricing  
6 methodology for stove oil heating fuel and  
7 gasoline motor fuel maximum prices in Zone 11a -  
8 Coastal Labrador South (Tanker Supplied) pursuant  
9 to Section 14.(2.6) of the **Petroleum Products**  
10 **Regulations**; and

12 **IN THE MATTER OF** the retail maximum  
13 prices for stove oil heating fuel and full-serve  
14 gasoline motor fuel chargeable by Black Tickle  
15 Convenience and Gas Inc. in Zone 11a - Coastal  
16 Labrador South (Tanker Supplied).

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19 **WHEREAS** Order No. P.P. 30(2023) approved a retail maximum price that could be charged by  
20 Black Tickle Convenience and Gas Inc. ("BTCCG") for stove oil heating fuel in Zone 11a - Coastal  
21 Labrador South (Tanker Supplied) of 185.05 cents per litre, exclusive of applicable taxes,  
22 effective May 4, 2023 until further order of the Board; and

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24 **WHEREAS** Order No. P.P. 55(2023) approved a retail maximum price that could be charged by  
25 BTCCG for full-serve regular gasoline motor fuel in Zone 11a - Coastal Labrador South (Tanker  
26 Supplied) of 208.0 cents per litre, inclusive of applicable taxes, effective August 31, 2023 until  
27 further order of the Board; and

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29 **WHEREAS** on October 7, 2023 BTCCG received a subsequent delivery of stove oil heating fuel and  
30 gasoline motor fuel to its retail location; and

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32 **WHEREAS** on October 24, 2023 the Board requested cost, volumetric and delivery information  
33 with respect to petroleum products at BTCCG's retail location; and

1 **WHEREAS** on October 25, 2023 BTCG provided responses to the Board's request for  
2 information; and

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4 **WHEREAS** BTCG indicated that this is the first delivery of stove oil heating fuel that has  
5 occurred at the retail location since November 2022, and the first delivery of gasoline motor  
6 fuel that has occurred at the retail location since August 2023; and

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8 **WHEREAS** based on its review of the cost, volumetric and delivery information provided by  
9 BTCG with respect to stove oil heating fuel and gasoline motor fuel the Board is satisfied that an  
10 alternative methodology should be established for stove oil heating fuel and full-serve regular  
11 gasoline motor fuel maximum retail prices for BTCG in Zone 11a - Coastal Labrador South  
12 (Tanker Supplied) to reflect the cost of the products that were purchased in October 2023; and

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14 **WHEREAS** the Board finds that a retail maximum price of up to 176.52 cents per litre, excluding  
15 applicable taxes, should be established for BTCG for stove oil heating fuel in Zone 11a - Coastal  
16 Labrador South (Tanker Supplied); and

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18 **WHEREAS** the Board finds that a retail maximum price of up to 199.1 cents per litre, including  
19 applicable taxes, should be established for BTCG for full-serve regular gasoline motor fuel in  
20 Zone 11a - Coastal Labrador South (Tanker Supplied).

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23 **IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:**


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25 1. Black Tickle Convenience and Gas Inc. can charge a retail maximum price of up to 176.52  
26 cents per litre, taxes excluded, for stove oil heating fuel in Zone 11a - Coastal Labrador  
27 South (Tanker Supplied), effective 12:01 a.m., Thursday, November 2, 2023, until further  
28 Order of the Board.


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30 2. Black Tickle Convenience and Gas Inc. can charge a retail maximum price of up to 199.1  
31 cents per litre, taxes included, for full-serve regular gasoline motor fuel in Zone 11a -  
32 Coastal Labrador South (Tanker Supplied), effective 12:01 a.m., Thursday, November 2,  
33 2023, until further Order of the Board.
