1 **IN THE MATTER OF** the **Petroleum**
2 **Products Act**, SNL 2001, Chapter P-10.1
3 and regulations thereunder; and

5 **IN THE MATTER OF** the setting of maximum prices to
6 be charged for gasoline motor fuel, diesel motor fuel
7 and stove oil heating fuel in Zones 10, 11, 11a, 11b,
8 12 and 14; and

10 **IN THE MATTER OF** the lifting of the current
11 suspension of maximum price adjustments for
12 gasoline motor fuel, diesel motor fuel and stove oil
13 heating fuel in Zones 10, 11, 11a, 11b, 12 and 14.

16 **WHEREAS** Order No. P.P. 42(2023) suspended maximum price adjustments for gasoline and
17 diesel motor fuels and stove oil heating fuel in Zones 10, 11, 11a, 11b, 12 and 14, effective June
18 29, 2023; and

20 **WHEREAS** Order No. P.P. 56(2023) lifted the suspension implemented in Order No. P.P. 42(2023)
21 for gasoline and diesel motor fuels and stove oil heating fuel in Zones 10, 11 and 11b effective
22 August 31, 2023; and

24 **WHEREAS** the Board adjusted maximum prices in Zones 10, 11 and 11b and Order No. P.P.
25 56(2023) suspended maximum price adjustments for gasoline and diesel motor fuels and stove
26 oil heating fuel in Zones 10, 11, and 11b effective August 31, 2023; and

28 **WHEREAS** based on delivery information provided to the Board by suppliers to the region
29 resupply of gasoline and diesel motor fuels and stove oil heating fuel to Zones 10, 11, 11a, 11b,
30 12 and 14 has commenced; and

1 **WHEREAS** the Board is satisfied that it is reasonable to lift the suspension of maximum price
2 adjustments for gasoline motor fuel, diesel motor fuel and stove oil heating fuel in these zones
3 to allow for the implementation of new benchmark prices to more reasonably reflect the cost of
4 the products.



7 **IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:**


