AN ORDER OF THE BOARD

NO. P.P. 92(2026)

IN THE MATTER OF the **Petroleum Products Act**, SNL 2001, Chapter P-10.1 and regulations thereunder; and

IN THE MATTER OF the resupply and setting of maximum prices to be charged for gasoline motor fuels in Zones 11a and 14; and

IN THE MATTER OF changes with respect to the wholesale mark-ups and total allowed mark-ups for gasoline motor fuels in Zones 11a and 14; and

IN THE MATTER OF changes with respect to the carbon price adjustment for gasoline motor fuels in Zones 11a and 14; and

IN THE MATTER OF the suspension of maximum price adjustments for gasoline motor fuels in Zones 11a and 14.

WHEREAS in Order No. P.P. 76(2025) the Board suspended maximum price adjustments for gasoline and diesel motor fuels and stove oil heating fuel in Zones 10, 11, 11a, 11c, 12 and 14 effective December 19, 2025; and

WHEREAS based on delivery information provided to the Board by suppliers to the region, resupply of gasoline motor fuels to Zones 11a and 14 has occurred; and

WHEREAS the Board is satisfied that it is reasonable to lift the suspension of maximum price adjustments for gasoline motor fuels in Zones 11a and 14 to allow for the implementation of new benchmark prices, carbon price adjustment and mark-ups effective June 30, 2026; and

WHEREAS in Order No. P.P. 77(2025) effective December 19, 2025 the Board implemented a carbon price adjustment of 8.68 cents per litre for gasoline motor fuels in Zones 11a and 14; and

1 **WHEREAS** in Order No. P.P. 50(2026) the Board approved a carbon price adjustment of 10.50
2 cents per litre for gasoline motor fuels for zones on the Island portion of the Province and in
3 Zones 13 and 13a in Western Labrador effective May 7, 2026; and

5 **WHEREAS** in Order No. P.P. 62(2026) the Board approved new wholesale and total allowed mark-
6 ups for gasoline motor fuel on the Island portion of the province and in Zones 13 and 13a in
7 Western Labrador effective May 22, 2026; and

9 **WHEREAS** in Order No. P.P. 80(2026) the Board approved new benchmark prices, carbon price
10 adjustments and wholesale and total allowed mark-ups for gasoline motor fuel in Zones 10, 11,
11 11c, 12 and 14 in Labrador effective June 16, 2026 following resupply of gasoline to the region;

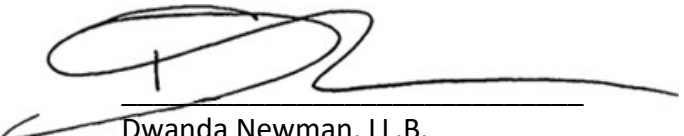
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14 **WHEREAS** the Board is satisfied that it is appropriate to align the carbon price adjustment and
15 the mark-ups for gasoline motor fuels in Zones 11a and 14 with those in the rest of the Province;
16 and

18 **WHEREAS** based on delivery information provided the Board is satisfied that a suspension of
19 maximum price adjustments for gasoline motor fuels in Zones 11a and 14 should be implemented
20 following the adjustments to the benchmark prices, carbon price adjustment, and mark-ups
21 effective June 30, 2026.

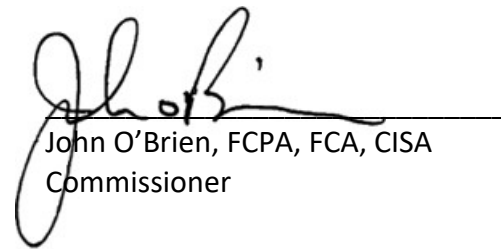
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24 **IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:**

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26 1. The suspension of maximum price adjustments for gasoline motor fuels in Zones 11a and 14
27 implemented pursuant to Order No. P.P. 76(2025) is lifted, effective June 30, 2026.
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29 2. A carbon price adjustment of 10.50 cents per litre for gasoline motor fuels is approved for
30 Zones 11a and 14, effective June 30, 2026.
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32 3. The wholesale and total allowed mark-ups for gasoline motor fuels, as set out in Schedule A
33 to this Order, are approved for Zones 11a and 14, effective June 30, 2026.
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35 4. The maximum prices for gasoline motor fuels in Zones 11a and 14 will be adjusted effective
36 June 30, 2026 to reflect the new cost of resupply, until further order of the Board.
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38 5. Maximum price adjustments for gasoline motor fuels in Zones 11a and 14 shall be suspended
39 as of the scheduled maximum price adjustment effective June 30, 2026, until further order of
40 the Board.
