AN ORDER OF THE BOARD

IN THE MATTER OF the Petroleum Products

**Act, SNL 2001, Chapter P-10.1 and
regulations thereunder; and**

**IN THE MATTER OF the resupply and setting
of maximum prices to be charged for diesel
motor fuel and stove oil heating fuel in Zones 10,
11, 11a, 11c, 12 and 14; and**

**IN THE MATTER OF changes with respect to the
wholesale mark-ups and total allowed mark-ups
for diesel motor fuel and stove oil heating fuel in
Zones 10, 11, 11a, 11c, 12 and 14; and**

**IN THE MATTER OF changes with respect to the
carbon price adjustment for diesel motor fuel in
Zones 10, 11, 11a, 11c, 12 and 14; and**

**IN THE MATTER OF the suspension of maximum
price adjustments for diesel motor fuel and stove oil
heating fuel in Zones 10, 11, 11a, 11c, 12 and 14.**

WHEREAS in Order No. P.P. 76(2025) the Board suspended maximum price adjustments for diesel motor fuel and stove oil heating fuel in Zones 10, 11, 11a, 11c, 12 and 14 effective December 19, 2025; and

WHEREAS based on delivery information provided to the Board by suppliers to the region, resupply of diesel motor fuel and stove oil heating fuel to Zones 10, 11, 11a, 11c, 12 and 14 has occurred; and

WHEREAS the Board is satisfied that it is reasonable to lift the suspension of maximum price adjustments for diesel motor fuel and stove oil heating fuel in Zones 10, 11, 11a, 11c, 12 and 14 to allow for the implementation of new benchmark prices, a new carbon price adjustment for diesel, and new mark-ups effective July 9, 2026; and

WHEREAS in Order No. P.P. 77(2025) effective December 19, 2025 the Board approved a carbon price adjustment of 9.67 cents per litre for diesel motor fuel in Zones 10, 11, 11a, 11c, 12 and 14; and

WHEREAS in Order No. P.P. 50(2026) the Board approved a carbon price adjustment of 11.00 cents per litre for diesel motor fuel for zones on the Island portion of the Province and in Zones 13 and 13a in Western Labrador effective May 7, 2026; and

WHEREAS in Order No. P.P. 62(2026) the Board approved new wholesale and total allowed mark-ups for diesel motor fuel and heating oil fuels on the Island portion of the province and in Zones 13 and 13a in Western Labrador effective May 22, 2026; and

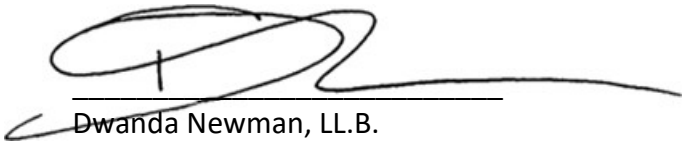
WHEREAS the Board is satisfied that it is appropriate to align the carbon price adjustment for diesel motor fuel, and the mark-ups for diesel motor fuel and stove oil heating fuel, in Zones 10, 11, 11a, 11c, 12 and 14 with those in the rest of the Province; and

WHEREAS based on delivery information provided the Board is satisfied that a suspension of maximum price adjustments for diesel motor fuel and stove oil heating fuel in Zones 10, 11, 11a, 11c, 12 and 14 should be implemented following the adjustments to the benchmark prices, carbon price adjustments, and mark-ups effective July 9, 2026.

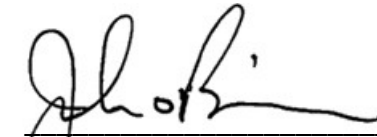
IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:

1. The suspension of maximum price adjustments for diesel motor fuel and stove oil heating fuel in Zones 10, 11, 11a, 11c, 12 and 14 implemented pursuant to Order No. P.P. 76(2025) is lifted, effective July 9, 2026.
2. A carbon price adjustment of 11.00 cents per litre for diesel motor fuel is approved for Zones 10, 11, 11a, 11c, 12 and 14, effective July 9, 2026.
3. The wholesale and total allowed mark-ups for diesel motor fuel and stove oil heating fuel, as set out in Schedule A to this Order, are approved for Zones 10, 11, 11a, 11c, 12 and 14, effective July 9, 2026.
4. The maximum prices for diesel motor fuel and stove oil heating fuel in Zones 10, 11, 11a, 11c, 12 and 14 will be adjusted effective July 9, 2026 to reflect the new cost of resupply, until further order of the Board.
5. Maximum price adjustments for diesel motor fuel and stove oil heating fuel in Zones 10, 11, 11a, 11c, 12 and 14 shall be suspended as of the scheduled maximum price adjustment effective July 9, 2026, until further order of the Board.
