**Extraordinary Adjustment of Maximum Prices of
Certain Regulated Petroleum Products**

Due to recent commodity market developments, the Public Utilities Board will intervene and adjust maximum prices outside its regular pricing schedule for gasoline and diesel motor fuels and furnace oil and stove oil heating fuels in all areas of the province except where maximum price adjustments have been suspended.

Effective 12:01 a.m. Friday, October 7, 2022, the changes to maximum prices are as follows:

- all types of gasoline motor fuel will increase by up to 9.3 cents per litre (cpl);
- diesel motor fuel will increase by up to 17.1 cpl;
- furnace oil heating fuel will increase by 14.82 cpl;
- stove oil heating fuel on the Island will increase by 15.44 cpl; and,
- stove oil heating fuel in Labrador will increase by 12.97 cpl.

These maximum prices reflect the change in the average benchmark price of the products since the Board last adjusted maximum prices on Thursday, October 6, 2022. While the Board's next regularly scheduled price adjustment is scheduled for Thursday, October 13, 2022 the Board continues to monitor the daily benchmark prices for motor fuels and heating fuels using the prescribed sources set out in the Petroleum Products Regulations and will adjust maximum prices outside the scheduled adjustment if circumstances warrant.
