**Extraordinary Adjustment of Maximum Prices of
Certain Regulated Petroleum Products**

Due to recent commodity market developments, the Public Utilities Board will intervene and adjust maximum prices outside its regular pricing schedule for furnace oil heating fuel.

Effective 12:01 a.m. Saturday, November 19, 2022, the changes to maximum prices are as follows:

- furnace oil heating fuel will decrease by 8.29 cents per litre.

These maximum prices reflect the change in the average benchmark price of the product since the Board last adjusted maximum prices on Thursday, November 17, 2022. While the Board's next regularly scheduled price adjustment is scheduled for Thursday, November 24, 2022 the Board continues to monitor the daily benchmark prices for motor fuels and heating fuels using the prescribed sources set out in the Petroleum Products Regulations and will adjust maximum prices outside the scheduled adjustment if circumstances warrant.
