Extraordinary Adjustment of Maximum Prices of Regulated Petroleum Products to Reflect Changes to Federal Carbon Tax

Extraordinary Maximum Price Adjustment

Effective 12:01 a.m. Tuesday, April 1, 2025, the Public Utilities Board set maximum prices for gasoline and diesel motor fuels in all areas of the province to reflect changes to the Federal Fuel Charge rates (Carbon Tax).

The changes to maximum fuel prices are as follows:

- all types of gasoline motor fuel will decrease by up to 20.3 cents per litre ("cpl"); and,
- diesel motor fuel will decrease by up to 24.6 cpl.

Motor Fuels

The impact of the changes to the federal Carbon Tax on motor fuel maximum prices in the province is set out in the table below:

Heating Fuels

Furnace oil and stove oil heating fuels are currently exempt from the federal Carbon Tax. Therefore maximum prices for furnace oil and stove oil will not be adjusted at this time.

The federal Carbon Tax rate for propane heating fuel is currently 12.38 cents per litre, which is also being reduced to zero by the Government of Canada. The Board's posted maximum prices for propane do not include taxation and therefore the Board's published maximum prices for propane heating fuel will not be adjusted at this time.
