2	residences at Goose Cove with single-phase electrical service which, in order to so provide, requires
3	the construction of a single-phase extension of 289 metres (the "Extension"); and

5	WHEREAS the Extension will be jointly used by the Applicant and Aliant Telecom Inc.;
6	and
7	WHEREAS a CIAC of the Extension has been calculated in accordance with Clauses 5(b)
8	and 5(c) of the CIAC Policy: Distribution Line Extensions to Residential and Seasonal Residential
9	Customers approved by Order No. P.U. 7 (1997-98) dated September 30, 1997 (the "Policy") and
10	the CIAC thus calculated is Four thousand one hundred eighty-three dollars and seventy cents
11	(\$4,183.70), including HST; and
12	
13	WHEREAS Clause 12(c) of the Policy states that all CIACs for Main Line extensions for
14	primarily seasonal residential customers be submitted to the Board for approval; and
15	
16	WHEREAS the proposed CIAC is necessary to ensure that the Applicant's investment in
17	the Extension is compensatory over the useful life of the Extension and will not be to the detriment
18	of the Applicant's other customers.
19	

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:

2	Pursuant to Section 41(5) of the <i>Act</i> , the Board approves a contribution in aid of construction			
3	in the amount of Four thousand one hundred eighty-three dollars and seventy cents (\$4,183.70)			
4	including HST, as calculated under the Policy to provide single phase service to two Seasona			
5	Customers, located at Goose Cove near Trinity, Trinity Bay.
