21	WHEREAS Hydro is a corporation continued and existing under the Hydro Corporation Act, is		
22	a public utility within the meaning of the Act, and is subject to the provisions of the Electrica		
23	Power Control Act, 1994; and

25	WHEREAS Section 41(3) of the Act requires that a public utility shall not proceed with the		
26	construction, purchase or lease of improvements or additions to its property where:		
27			
28	(a) the cost of construction or purchase is in excess of \$50,000; or		
29	(b) the cost of the lease is in excess of \$5,000 in a year of the lease		
30	(b) the cost of the lease is in excess of \$5,000 in a year of the lease		
31	without the prior approval of the Board of Commissioners of Public Utilities (the "Board"); and		
32	minion the prior approvar or the Board of Commissioners of Facility (the Board ), and		
33	WHEREAS by Order No. P. U. 31 (2005) the Board approved Hydro's 2006 capita		
34	expenditures in the amount of \$42,636,000; and

1	WHEREAS on February 2, 2006 Hydro filed an application with the Board pursuant to Section			
2	41(3) of the Act, seeking approval of additional 2006 capital expenditures totalling \$183,800 for			
3	the purchase and installation of a 725 kW engine for a diesel generating unit at Hydro's diese			
4	generating station in Charlottetown to replace Unit # 2060, one of the same capacity that ha			
5	failed and is uneconomic to repair; and			
6				
7	WHEREAS Hydro provided as a Schedule to the application a capital proposal explanation fo			
8	this diesel engine replacement in accordance with the guidelines in Section 3 of Order No. P.U.			
9	7(2002-2003); and			
10				
11	WHEREAS the Board has considered the application, including the explanations contained in			
12	Schedule A, and is satisfied that the proposed expenditure is prudent and necessary in order to			
13	provide reasonably safe and adequate and just and reasonable service as required by the Act.			
14				
15				
16	IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:			
17				
18	1. Pursuant to Section 41(3) of the Act, the Board approves the supplemental 2006 capital			
19	expenditure as follows:			
20	(i) an amount of \$183,800 for the replacement of a diesel engine for a generating			
21	unit at Hydro's Charlottetown diesel generating station.			
22				
23	2. Hydro shall pay the expenses of the Board incurred in connection with this matter.
