- 1 **IN THE MATTER OF** the *Electrical Power*
- 2 *Control Act*, RSNL 1994, Chapter E-5.1 (the
- 3 "EPCA") and the Public Utilities Act, RSNL 1990,
- 4 Chapter P-47 (the "*Act*"), as amended;

AND

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- 8 **IN THE MATTER OF** an Application by
- 9 Newfoundland Power Inc. ("Newfoundland
- 10 Power") for approval to proceed with the
- 11 construction and purchase of certain
- 12 improvements to its property pursuant to
- 13 Section 41(3) of the *Act* (the "Application").
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- WHEREAS Newfoundland Power is a corporation duly organized and existing under the laws of
  the Province of Newfoundland and Labrador, is a public utility within the meaning of the *Act*, and is
  also subject to the provisions of the *Electrical Power Control Act*, 1994; and
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- WHEREAS Section 41 of the *Act* requires that a public utility shall not proceed with the construction, purchase or lease of improvements or additions to its property where the cost of the construction or purchase is in excess of \$50,000 or the cost of the lease is in excess of \$5,000 in a year of the lease without the prior approval of the Board; and
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WHEREAS during the summer and fall of 2008 the City of St. John's ("the City") will complete two phases of the Harbour Interceptor Sewer project, which project will involve street closures and excavation along Water Street and Harbour Drive, and the placement of various conduits, pipes and manholes under the roadways; and

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- 30 **WHEREAS** the City has offered to accommodate the installation of underground civil infrastructure 31 for utility power cables in the work associated with the Harbour Interceptor Sewer project; and

- 33 WHEREAS Newfoundland Power proposes improvements and additions to its property to provide
- 34 for the installation of underground civil infrastructure for utility power cables in the Water Street
- and Harbour Drive areas of St. John's involving an estimated 2008 expenditure of \$1,930,000; and

WHEREAS the proposed expenditure is necessary for Newfoundland Power to provide service and 1 facilities associated with the underground distribution system in downtown St. John's which are 2 reasonably safe and adequate and just and reasonable as required pursuant to Section 37 of the Act. 3 4 5 6 **IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:** 7 8 1. The Board approves the additional 2008 capital expenditures of \$1,930,000 associated with 9 the installation of underground civil infrastructure for utility power cables in Water Street and Harbour Drive areas of St. John's. 10

12 2. Newfoundland Power shall pay all the expenses of the Board arising from this Application.
