32	WHEREAS	after examining the bids of prospective suppliers of photocopiers, Newfoundland	
33	Power has determined that purchasing the photocopiers is a lower cost option than leasing as was		
34		oposed in the 2008 Capital Budget filed on June 29, 2007; and

<b>WHEREAS</b> Newfoundland Power now proposes purchasing rather than leasing the 17 photocopier at an estimated 2008 expenditure of \$105,000; and			
<b>WHEREAS</b> the proposed expenditure is necessary for Newfoundland Power to continue to provide service and facilities which are reasonably safe and adequate and just and reasonable as required pursuant to Section 37 of the <i>Act</i> .			
IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:			
1.	Pursuant to Section 41(3) of the <i>Act</i> the Board approves the additional 2008 capital expenditures associated with the purchase of 17 photocopiers as proposed in the Application.		
2.	Newfoundland Power shall pay all the expenses of the Board arising from this Application.
