15	WHEREAS	Hydro is a corporation continued and existing under the Hydro Corporation Act, is
16	a public utili	ity within the meaning of the Act and is also subject to the provisions of the EPCA;

19	WHEREAS	Section 41(3) of the Act requires that a public utility shall not proceed with the
20	construction	, purchase or lease of improvements or additions to its property where:

22 23	(a)	the cost of the construction or purchase is in excess of \$50,000; or
23	(b)	the cost of the lease is in excess of \$5,000 in a year of the lease,

25	without the p	prior approval of the Board; and

27	WHEREAS	in Order Nos. P. U. 30(2007), P. U. 31(2007), P. U. 9(2008) and P. U. 17(2008) the
28	Board appro	ved Hydro's estimated capital expenditure for 2008 totaling \$56,144,800; and

30	WHEREAS	Hydro owns and maintains approximately 450 km of roads dykes, and dams
31	associated w	rith its Bay d'Espoir hydro-electric facilities and requires heavy equipment for the
32	purpose of n	naintaining those roads and facilities; and

purc	EREAS on September 26, 2008 Hydro applied to the Board requesting approval to hase, at an estimated cost of \$220,000, a front end loader to replace a front end loader that d after 16 years of service and which was no longer economical to repair and maintain; and
	EREAS Hydro filed with the Application a report describing the equipment to be purchased the justification for the acquisition; and
	EREAS the Board has considered the Application for approval of the purchase and is fied that the proposed expenditure is justified.
IT I	S THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:
1.	Pursuant to Section 41(3) of the <i>Act</i> , the Board approves the additional capital expenditures of \$220,000 for the purchase of a front end loader.
2.	Hydro shall pay the expenses of the Board arising from this Application.
