22	conservation and demand management potential study prepared by Marbek Resources
23	Consultants which identified the potential contribution of specific technologies and measures in
24	reducing forecast electricity consumption (the "Potential Study"); and

26	WHEREAS on June 27, 2008, pursuant to Order No. P. U. 7(2008), a Five-Year Energy
27	Conservation Plan: 2008-2013 (the "Conservation Plan") was filed with the Board which sets out
28	the customer energy conservation programs proposed to be jointly implemented by Hydro and
29	Newfoundland Power; and

31	WHEREAS in Order No P. U. 14(2009) the Board approved Hydro's application for approval of
32	the deferred recovery of the 2009 costs to be incurred by Hydro in association with the
