- 11 of a Contribution in Aid of Construction for
- 12 a line extension to serve Domestic Customers

- WHEREAS Newfoundland Power Inc. ("Newfoundland Power") is a corporation duly
 organized and existing under the laws of the Province of Newfoundland and Labrador, is a
 public utility within the meaning of the *Act*, and is also subject to the provisions of the
- 20 *EPCA*; and
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WHEREAS on August 4, 2011 Newfoundland Power filed an application for approval of a Contribution in Aid of Construction ("CIAC") for a single-phase line extension of approximately 5,253 metres (the Extension") to serve Domestic Customers in a cottage area known as Muddy Hole located on the Burin Peninsula; and

- WHEREAS ten of nineteen potential customers have requested that Newfoundland Power
 provide electrical service (the "Participating Customers"); and
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- WHEREAS the Participating Customers have requested the Non-Refundable CIAC Option
 provided for in Clause 6 of Newfoundland Power's CIAC Policy; and
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- WHEREAS the number of Participating Customers meets the minimum participation
 percentage of 50% required to avail of the Non-Refundable CIAC Option; and
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- WHEREAS the Non-Refundable CIAC, calculated in accordance with Clause 6 of the
 CIAC Policy, is ten thousand four hundred and twenty-two dollars and ninety cents
 (\$10,422.90), excluding HST; and

WHEREAS the sum of the Non-Refundable CIAC calculated pursuant to Clause 6 and the
Basic Investment calculated pursuant to Clause 3 exceeds \$50,000, and therefore in
accordance with Clause 10(i) of the CIAC Policy Board approval is required; and

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6 **WHEREAS** the proposed CIAC is necessary to ensure that Newfoundland Power's 7 investment is compensatory over the useful life of the Extension and will not be to the 8 detriment of Newfoundland Power's other customers.

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10 IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:

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 The Non-Refundable Contribution in Aid of Construction of ten thousand four hundred and twenty-two dollars and ninety cents (\$10,422.90), excluding HST, to apply to Domestic Customers located in the cottage area known as Muddy Pond is approved.

16 2. Newfoundland Power shall pay all expenses of the Board arising from this Application.
