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15	WHEREAS Newfoundland and Labrador Hydro ("Hydro") is a corporation continued and
16	existing under the Hydro Corporation Act, is a public utility within the meaning of the Act, and
17	is also subject to the provisions of the EPCA; and
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19	WHEREAS Section 41(3) of the Act requires that a public utility not proceed with the
20	construction, purchase or lease of improvements or additions to its property where:
21	a) the cost of construction or purchase is in excess of \$50,000; or
22	b) the cost of the lease is in excess of \$5,000 in a year of the lease,
23	without prior approval of the Board; and
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25	WHEREAS in Order No. P.U. 38(2010), issued December 23, 2010, the Board approved, inter-
26	alia, Hydro's 2011 Capital Budget of \$55,046,000; and
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28	WHEREAS on March 7, 2011 Hydro applied to the Board requesting approval to enter into a
29	one-year lease for residential accommodation in Labrador City or Wabush for its lineworkers
30	temporarily stationed in Labrador West to support Hydro's Labrador west operations (the
31	"Application"); and
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33	WHEREAS Hydro advised that it intends to enter into a lease for residential accommodations,
34	has issued a tender and anticipates the annual rent to be between \$40,000 and \$60,000 per year
35	(plus HST); and

1 2	WHEREAS on March 7, 2011 copies of the Application were circulated to the Consumer Advocate, Newfoundland Power Inc., and Hydro's Industrial Customers; and
3 4	WHEREAS the Board issued requests for information which were answered by Hydro on March 15, 2011; and
6	WHEREAS on March 15, 2011 the Consumer Advocate advised that he did not intend to

WHEREAS Newfoundland Power Inc. and Hydro's Industrial Customers did not comment on the Application; and

WHEREAS the Board is satisfied that it is reasonable and prudent to approve a one-year lease of residential accommodations in Labrador City or Wabush in an amount not to exceed \$60,000 per year, plus HST.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:

comment on the Application; and

1. The Application to enter into a one-year lease of residential accommodations in Labrador City or Wabush in an amount not to exceed \$60,000 per year, plus HST, is approved.

2. Hydro shall file a copy of the executed lease with the Board.

3. Hydro shall pay all expenses of the Board arising from this Application.
