5	WHEREAS Newfoundland Power Inc. ("Newfoundland Power") is a corporation duly
6	organized and existing under the laws of the Province of Newfoundland and Labrador, is a public
7	utility within the meaning of the Act, and is also subject to the provisions of the EPCA; and
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9	WHEREAS by Order No P.U. 1(1974) the Board ordered that Newfoundland Power provide a
0	reserve out of its revenue to normalize for the average degree days (the "Degree Day
:1	Normalization Reserve") and to combine the balance in this reserve with the balance in the
2	Hydro Production Equalization Reserve established pursuant to Order No. P.U. 32(1968) to
:3	create a combined reserve referred to as the Weather Normalization Reserve; and

:5	WHEREAS by Order No. P.U. 32(2007), the Board ordered Newfoundland Power to amortize
6	the recovery of \$6,800,000 of the balance in the Degree Day Normalization Reserve over a five
27	year period beginning in 2008; and

9	WHEREAS the Board, by previous Orders, approved Newfoundland Power's Weather
0	Normalization Reserve balance up to and including December 31, 2009, at which time there was
1	a negative balance in the reserve of \$3,918,970; and
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3	WHEREAS Newfoundland Power has reported to the Board that its Weather Normalization
4	Reserve as of December 31, 2010 has a Positive Balance of \$1,954,953; and
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6	WHEREAS the Board is satisfied from the Application and Affidavit that the reserve at
37	December 31, 2010, properly reflects the effect that degree days normalization and hydro

production equalization have had on the operation of Newfoundland Power from January 1, 2010 1 2 to December 31, 2010, and the Board's approval of the amortization of the recovery of 3 \$6,800,000 of the balance in the Degree Day Normalization Reserve over five years beginning in 4 2008. 5 6 IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:

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The Board approves, pursuant to Sections 69(3) and 78 of the Act, Newfoundland 1. Power's Weather Normalization Reserve of a positive balance of \$1,954,953 as of December 31, 2010.

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Newfoundland Power shall pay all costs and expenses of the Board in connection 2. with this Application.
