14 WHEREAS Newfoundland and Labrador Hydro ("Hydro") is a corporation continued and 15 existing under the *Hydro Corporation Act, 2007*, is a public utility within the meaning of the *Act*, 16 and is subject to the provisions of the *EPCA*; and

18 WHEREAS Section 41(3) of the *Act* requires that a public utility not proceed with the 19 construction, purchase or lease of improvements or additions to its property where:

- a) the cost of construction or purchase is in excess of \$50,000; or
- b) the cost of the lease is in excess of \$5,000 in a year of the lease,
- 24 without prior approval of the Board; and
- WHEREAS a Decision and Order relating to Hydro's 2013 Capital Budget application is
   pending; and
- WHEREAS on January 4, 2013, Hydro applied to the Board requesting approval of the capital
  expenditure of \$284,100 for the refurbishment of the stop logs at the Burnt Dam Spillway; and

- 32 WHEREAS in Order Nos. P.U. 2(2012) and P.U. 5(2012) the Board approved Hydro's 2012 33 Capital Budget, including the inspection of the Burnt Dam Spillway; and
- 34 WHEREAS Hydro advises that, in order to ensure safe access to the spillway for the inspection, 35 the stop logs must be able to prevent water from entering the gate well which is not achieved

36 with current condition of the stop logs; and

1 WHEREAS the Board requested comments from interested parties by January 14, 2013; and

WHEREAS the Consumer Advocate, the Industrial Customers and Newfoundland Power Inc.
advised that they did not have comments; and

WHEREAS the Board has reviewed the Application and is satisfied that the capital expenditure
 for refurbishment of the stop logs at the Burnt Dam Spillway is necessary to allow Hydro to
 provide service and facilities which are reasonably safe and adequate and just and reasonable.
