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16	WHEREAS Newfoundland Power Inc. ("Newfoundland Power") is a corporation duly
17	organized and existing under the laws of the Province of Newfoundland and Labrador, is a
18	public utility within the meaning of the Act, and is also subject to the provisions of the
19	EPCA; and

21	WHEREAS on May 6, 2013 Newfoundland Power filed an application for approval of a
22	Contribution in Aid of Construction ("CIAC") for a single-phase line extension of
23	approximately 2,875 metres (the "Extension") to serve Domestic Customers in a cottage area known as Pitts Pond South, near the community of Terra Nova; and
24 25	area known as Pius Pond South, hear the community of Terra Nova; and
25 26	WHEREAS seven of the fourteen potential customers have requested that Newfoundland
20 27	Power provide electrical service (the "Participating Customers"); and
28	Tower provide electrical service (the Tartierpating Castomers), and
29 29	WHEREAS the Participating Customers have requested the Non-Refundable CIAC Option
30	provided for in Clause 6 of Newfoundland Power's CIAC Policy; and
31	provided for all charge of critical district of carriers of carriers
32	WHEREAS the number of Participating Customers meets the minimum participation
33	percentage of 50% required to avail of the Non-Refundable CIAC option; and
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35	WHEREAS the Non-Refundable CIAC, calculated in accordance with Clause 6 of the
36	CIAC Policy, is seven thousand eight hundred forty-three dollars and seventy-five cents
37	(\$7,843.75), excluding HST; and

WHEREAS the sum of the Non-Refundable CIAC calculated pursuant to Clause 6 and the Basic Investment calculated pursuant to Clause 3 exceeds \$50,000, and therefore in accordance with Clause 10(i) of the CIAC Policy Board approval is required; and

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WHEREAS the proposed CIAC is necessary to ensure that Newfoundland Power's investment is compensatory over the useful life of the Extension and will not be to the detriment of Newfoundland Power's other customers.

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IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:

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13 14 1. The Non-Refundable Contribution in Aid of Construction of seven thousand eight hundred forty-three dollars and seventy-five cents (\$7,843.75), excluding HST, to apply to Domestic Customers located in the Cottage Area known as Pitts Pond South is approved.

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2. Newfoundland Power shall pay all expenses of the Board arising from this Application.
