AN ORDER OF THE BOARD

1 **IN THE MATTER OF** the *Electrical Power*
2 *Control Act, 1994*, SNL 1994, Chapter E-5.1 (the
3 “*EPCA*”) and the *Public Utilities Act, RSNL 1990*,
4 Chapter P-47 (the “*Act*”), as amended, and regulations
5 thereunder; and

7 **IN THE MATTER OF** an application by
8 Newfoundland Power Inc. for approval of a
9 Contribution in Aid of Construction for
10 three-phase service to the Town of
11 Conception Bay South, pursuant to
12 section 41 of the *Act*.

15 **WHEREAS** Newfoundland Power Inc. (“Newfoundland Power”) is a corporation duly
16 organized and existing under the laws of the Province of Newfoundland and Labrador, is a
17 public utility within the meaning of the *Act*, and is also subject to the provisions of the *EPCA*;

20 **WHEREAS** the Town of Conception Bay South (the “Customer”) operates a waste
21 management station located on Seal Cove Road in the Town of Conception Bay South; and
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23 **WHEREAS** on April 12, 2017 Newfoundland Power filed an application for approval of a
24 Contribution in Aid of Construction (“CIAC”) to upgrade approximately 2,074 metres of
25 single-phase line to three-phase and to construct a three-phase line extension of approximately
26 244 metres (the “Extension”) to provide service to the Customer’s facility; and

28 **WHEREAS** on May 16, 2017 Newfoundland Power filed an amended application to correct
29 the calculation of the CIAC; and
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31 **WHEREAS** the CIAC, calculated in accordance with Clause 5(e) of the CIAC Policy:
32 Distribution Line Extensions and Upgrades to General Service Customers approved by Order
33 No. P.U. 27(2005) (the “Policy”), is two hundred and thirteen thousand seven hundred dollars
34 and forty six cents (\$213,700.46), excluding HST; and

36 **WHEREAS** Clause 10(ii) of the Policy states that the Company shall apply to the Board for
37 approval of all line extensions or upgrades involving CIACs where the cost of the line
38 extension or upgrade is calculated pursuant to Clause 5(e); and

1 **WHEREAS** the proposed CIAC is necessary to ensure that Newfoundland Power's investment
2 in the Extension is compensatory over the useful life of the Extension and will not be to the
3 detriment of its other customers.
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
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6 **IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:**
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- 8 1. The Contribution in Aid of Construction of two hundred and thirteen thousand seven
9 hundred dollars and forty six cents (\$213,700.46), excluding HST, to provide three-phase
10 service to a waste management station in the Town of Conception Bay South is approved.

12 2. Newfoundland Power shall pay all expenses of the Board arising from this Application.
