AN ORDER OF THE BOARD

1 **IN THE MATTER OF** the *Electrical Power*
2 *Control Act, 1994*, SNL 1994, Chapter E-5.1 (the
3 “*EPCA*”) and the *Public Utilities Act*, RSNL
4 1990, Chapter P-47 (the “*Act*”), as amended,
5 and regulations thereunder; and

7 **IN THE MATTER OF** an application by
8 Newfoundland and Labrador Hydro for approval
9 of a Contribution in Aid of Construction to provide
10 service to the Western Regional Service Board’s waste
11 transfer facility located on Route 420 near Hampden
12 Junction, pursuant to section 41 of the *Act*.

15 **WHEREAS** Newfoundland and Labrador Hydro (“Hydro”) is a corporation continued and
16 existing under the *Hydro Corporation Act, 2007*, is a public utility within the meaning of the
17 *Act*, and is also subject to the provisions of the *EPCA*; and

19 **WHEREAS** on January 17, 2018 Hydro filed an application for approval of a Contribution in
20 Aid of Construction (“CIAC”) to provide service to the Western Regional Service Board’s
21 waste transfer facility near the community of Hampden by constructing 6.5 kilometres of
22 single-phase distribution line from the Taylor Pond Substation along Route 420; and

24 **WHEREAS** the CIAC, calculated in accordance with Clause 5(e) of the CIAC Policy:
25 Distribution Line Extensions and Upgrades to General Service Customers approved by Order
26 No. P.U. 27(2005) (the “Policy”), is seven hundred and forty-eight thousand four hundred and
27 twenty dollars and twenty cents (\$748,420.20), excluding HST; and

29 **WHEREAS** Clause 10(ii) of the Policy states that the company shall apply to the Board for
30 approval of all line extensions or upgrades involving CIACs where the cost of the line
31 extension or upgrade is calculated pursuant to Clause 5(e); and
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33 **WHEREAS** the proposed CIAC is necessary to ensure that Hydro’s investment is
34 compensatory over the useful life of the upgrade and will not be to the detriment of its other
35 customers.


1 **IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:**

- 3 1. The Contribution in Aid of Construction of seven hundred and forty-eight thousand four
4 hundred and twenty dollars and twenty cents (\$748,420.20), excluding HST, to provide
5 service to the Western Regional Service Board's waste transfer facility located on Route
6 420 near Hampden Junction is approved.

8 2. Hydro shall pay all expenses of the Board arising from this Application.
