AN ORDER OF THE BOARD

NO. P.U. 8(2022)

1 **IN THE MATTER OF** the *Electrical Power*
2 *Control Act, 1994*, SNL 1994, Chapter E-5.1
3 (the “*EPCA*”) and the *Public Utilities Act*,
4 RSNL 1990, Chapter P-47 (the “*Act*”), as
5 amended, and regulations thereunder; and
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7 **IN THE MATTER OF** an application by
8 Newfoundland and Labrador Hydro for
9 approval of a Contribution in Aid of
10 Construction for a single-phase to three-phase
11 upgrade for a Parks Canada Visitor Information
12 Centre, pursuant to section 41 of the *Act*.

15 **WHEREAS** Newfoundland and Labrador Hydro (“Hydro”) is a corporation continued and
16 existing under the *Hydro Corporation Act, 2007*, is a public utility within the meaning of the *Act*,
17 and is also subject to the provisions of the *EPCA*; and
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19 **WHEREAS** on March 10, 2022 Hydro filed an application for approval of a Contribution in Aid
20 of Construction (“CIAC”) to upgrade approximately 3.0 km of single-phase distribution line to
21 three-phase distribution line for service to a Parks Canada Visitor Information Centre located in
22 Rocky Harbour; and

24 **WHEREAS** the CIAC, calculated in accordance with Clause 5(e) of the CIAC Policy: Distribution
25 Line Extensions and Upgrades to General Service Customers approved by Order No. P.U.
26 27(2005) (the “Policy”) is three hundred thirty-five thousand eight hundred ninety-eight dollars
27 and four cents (\$335,898.04), excluding HST; and

29 **WHEREAS** Clause 10(ii) of the Policy states that the company shall apply to the Board for
30 approval of all line extensions or upgrades involving CIAC’s where the cost of the line extension
31 or upgrade is calculated pursuant to Clauses 5(e); and
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33 **WHEREAS** the proposed CIAC is necessary to ensure Hydro’s investment is compensatory over
34 the useful life of the upgrade and will not be to the detriment of its other customers.

1 **IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:**


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1. The Contribution in Aid of Construction of three hundred thirty-five thousand eight hundred ninety-eight dollars and four cents (\$335,898.04), excluding HST, to apply to a Parks Canada Visitor Information Centre located in Rocky Harbour, is approved.
2. Hydro shall pay all expenses of the Board arising from this Application.
