**AN ORDER OF THE BOARD**

**NO. P.U. 20(2025)**

**IN THE MATTER OF** the **Electrical Power Control Act, 1994**, SNL 1994, Chapter E-5.1 (the “**EPCA**”) and the **Public Utilities Act**, RSNL 1990, Chapter P-47 (the “**Act**”), as amended, and regulations thereunder; and

**IN THE MATTER OF** an application by Newfoundland Power Inc. for approval of a Contribution in Aid of Construction for a Line Extension to Serve Potential Domestic Customers in Nine Island Pond cottage area, pursuant to section 41 of the **Act**.

**WHEREAS** Newfoundland Power Inc. (“Newfoundland Power”) is a corporation duly organized and existing under the laws of the Province of Newfoundland and Labrador, is a public utility within the meaning of the **Act**, and is also subject to the provisions of the **EPCA**; and

**WHEREAS** on May 22, 2025 Newfoundland Power filed an application for approval of a Contribution in Aid of Construction (“CIAC”) for a single-phase extension of approximately 1,272 metres for the future connection of electrical services for building lots under development by 94184 Newfoundland and Labrador Inc. in the Nine Island Pond cottage area located near the community of Colliers; and

**WHEREAS** the CIAC, calculated in accordance with Clause 5(a) of the CIAC Policy: Distribution Line Extensions to Domestic Customers approved by Order No. P.U. 27(2005) (the “Policy”) is seventy-six thousand, eight hundred fifty-seven dollars and zero cents (\$76,857.00), excluding HST; and


**WHEREAS** Clause 10(i) of the Policy states that approval of the Board is required where the sum of the CIAC calculated pursuant to Clauses 5(a) or 6(a) and the Basic and Additional Investment calculated pursuant to Clauses 3 and 4 are estimated to be greater than \$50,000; and

**WHEREAS** the proposed CIAC was calculated pursuant to Clause 5(a) and Clause 10(i) of the Policy.


1 **IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:**

- 8 2. Newfoundland Power Inc. shall pay all expenses of the Board arising from this Application.


