Q. At page 20 of Navigant Consulting Limited ("Navigant") report dated October 31, 1 2 2014, reference is made to the fact that in four jurisdictions in Canada (BC, MB, NS 3 and ON) a simplified and expedited process for systems that fall below a given capacity is offered. Three of these use a 10 k W limit and the other (BC) uses 27 4 5 kW. Has Newfoundland Power considered implementing a similar simplified and 6 expedited process for smaller systems, having regard to the fact that Newfoundland 7 Power has stated that it reserves the discretion to limit the size of proposed 8 customer generation?

A. Customers choosing to participate in Newfoundland Power's Net Metering Service Option will be required to complete the Net Metering Interconnection Application Form.¹ Once experience is gained in processing customer net metering applications, the Company intends to re-evaluate the application process to determine if an expedited process for small customer owned generating systems is appropriate. This is consistent with the approach of other Canadian jurisdictions.²
