2 sites from public roadsides? If this information is not currently available,
3 please provide the researched information as soon as possible, when it

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7 A. Hydro contacted New Brunswick Power, Hydro One, Altalink and ATCO
8 Electric. All responded that the issue of accessing sites from public roadsides
9 was not a safety problem because shoulders on the highways where they
10 must unload their vehicles are sufficiently wide that equipment can be
11 maneuvered safely without encroaching on the traffic lanes.
