3 Does Hydro believe that interrupting Curtailable Service customers when there is no
4 system need is consistent with its mandate to “provide least cost, reliable and safe
5 electricity to its customers”? Please explain.
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8 A. [] Hydro believes that requests for customers to curtail should be based upon
9 ensuring the system can meet customers' load requirements.
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11 As outlined in Section 4.5.4, of the evidence to Hydro’s Amended Application,
12 Hydro is proposing that the Board approve the treatment of Newfoundland Power’s
13 (NP) curtailable load as a credit to the NP billing demand. This proposal is
14 consistent with the Curtailable Credit Application Hydro filed with the Board on
15 September 19, 2014, but not yet ruled on by the Board.
