3            Please explain the dramatic reductions in forecast CDM spending in 2015 for the  
4            following programs indicated in the following table, and provide the reports, with  
5            precise references, in which this information can be found:

<b>Isolated Systems Communications</b>	\$625,901	\$0
<b>Isolated Systems Commercial Custom</b>	\$116,145	\$0
<b>"Year-End Balance" (Total)</b>	\$2,375,423	\$695,445

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8            In addition, please provide descriptions of the two Isolated Systems programs  
9            ("Communications" and "Commercial Custom") and explain why both are  
10           discontinued in 2015F.

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13    A.    The reduction in forecast CDM spending for the Residential windows program in  
14           2015 is due to the closure of the program as result of market saturation. Please  
15           refer to Hydro's response to CA-NLH-215 Attachment 1 (Revision 1, Nov 20-14);  
16           Table 6-10 on page 6-9; Section 6.4 on page 6-37; and to page 8-3.

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18           The program shown as "Isolated Systems Communications" in the above table is a  
19           typographical error and should read "Isolated Systems Community". Please refer  
20           Hydro's response to IN-NLH-165 for a description of this program. Please refer to  
21           Hydro's response to IN-NLH-240, which informs why the program ended in 2014.

1       The program shown as “Isolated Systems Commercial Custom” is the custom energy  
2       efficiency program that is available to business customers located in isolated diesel  
3       communities. This program is also referred to by the acronym ISBEP (Isolated  
4       Systems Business Efficiency Program). Please refer to Hydro's response to IN-NLH-  
5       165 Attachment 1, Section 5 for a description of ISBEP. This program has not been  
6       discontinued. In reference to the table shown in Hydro's response to IN-NLH-010  
7       (Revision 1, Dec 4-14) the ISBEP budget for 2015 is included with the business  
8       efficiency program for the Island Interconnected Commercial Custom (acronym  
9       BEP) since both of these programs are included in the CDM deferral account.  
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11      The overall Year End Balance (Total) difference between 2014 and 2015 is  
12      attributed to the closure of the programs for Residential windows and Isolated  
13      Systems Community as referenced above, and to the Industrial CDM Program which  
14      is not expected to see participation in 2015.
