

1 Q. Page 15 states: "I recommend that the Board maintain the current classification of  
2 wind generation until a full study is completed." Please confirm that the Board has  
3 not yet approved a classification approach for wind generation as there have been no  
4 costs associated with wind generation in previous test year cost service studies  
5 approved by the Board.

6 A. It is correct that the Board has not yet approved a classification for wind generation.  
7 The current classification that I referred to is the one which Hydro has used in its  
8 actual cost of service (COS) from 2008 through to 2013, that is, the percentage  
9 classified as energy is the same as the system load factor. See IC-NLH-002 and IC-  
10 NLH-002 revision 1, COS for each year, schedule 4.4, line 6
