6 the pump set which made the pump unable to deliver the required oil flow
7 to the bearings.” Please explain:

8 (a) What was the “particular failure” experienced within the pump set
9 that would have been detected by the check that was lacking?;

11 (b) What was the check that was lacking and how this check would
12 have detected the particular failure experienced?

14 CA-NLH-03 Reference: Page 2 – “The Investigation has identified that weekly testing
15 of the DC oil pump set was completed as required consistent with the
16 original equipment manufacturer guidelines.” Please describe the
17 weekly testing and provide a copy of the referenced manufacturer
18 guidelines.

8 CA-NLH-06 Will the costs of this project be recoverable by insurance proceeds?


9 Please explain the insurance coverage provided, if any, and the terms of
