

4 lines 20 to 23

5 Page 3 (lines 20 to 23) of the Evidence filed by Hydro reads:
6 “Therefore, the IC will see no change in the base rate amounts they
7 pay on their monthly bills. However, Hydro is proposing that the IC
8 RSP rate be adjusted to reflect the December 2013 current balance
9 and a fuel rider based upon the 2013 Test Year.” (emphasis
10 added). Consistent with this statement, the rates on page 5 of
11 Schedule A include a base rate that is stated to be subject to an RSP
12 adjustment and a calculated RSP adjustment of 0.051 c per kWh.
13 However, the interim rates at page 6 of Schedule A contain an RSP
14 adjustment of 0.00 c per kWh.

15 Please confirm that either (i) the interim rates will include an RSP
16 adjustment of 0.051 c per kWh or (ii) the RSP adjustment of 0.051 c
17 per kWh will be taken from the RSP Surplus account.
