


SIR-PUB-NLH-15 to SIR-PUB-NLH-21

Issued: June 24, 2014

- SIR-PUB-NLH-15** In its Interim Rates Application Hydro proposed a transfer of funds from the hydraulic production variation component of the Rate Stabilization Plan to be recognized as revenue in 2014 and the phase-in of Industrial Customer rates in 2014. As a result of this application, if it is approved, does Hydro intend to change customer rates for 2014? If so, how does Hydro plan to finalize 2014 rates? If not, what is Hydro's plan with regard to 2014 rates?
- SIR-PUB-NLH-16** On June 6, 2014 Hydro advised that it will be filing an amended 2013 General Rate Application ("GRA") in the fall of 2014 with the amended filing providing forecast information for 2014 and a 2015 test year. Explain in detail what the implications are, if any, for Hydro's Interim Rates Application dated May 12, 2014, arising from Hydro's plan to file the amended GRA in the fall.
- SIR-PUB-NLH-17** Further to SIR-PUB-NLH-16 explain in detail how Hydro proposes to finalize 2014 rates for customers if it does file updated 2014 financial information and a 2015 test year, including what test year would be appropriate to use to finalize 2014 rates.
- SIR-PUB-NLH-18** Does Hydro intend to file a 2014 test year when it files an amended 2013 General Rate Application in the fall of 2014? If no, explain in detail why not.
- SIR-PUB-NLH-19** In its letter of June 6, 2014, Hydro stated that the intended amendment in the fall of 2014 is dependent upon an amendment to the Order in Council which directs that rates be based upon a 2013 test year. Has Hydro received the amended Order in Council? If yes, provide a copy. If no, when does Hydro anticipate that the amendment will be made?
- SIR-PUB-NLH-20** Since Hydro intends to implement a rate change for the Industrial Customers on July 1, 2014 that will effect the phase-in of changes to rates using the RSP Surplus for the Industrial Customers, what is the latest date of a Board Order that will allow Hydro to implement a rate change to become effective on July 1, 2014? Explain why this date would be acceptable.
- SIR-PUB-NLH-21** Further to SIR-PUB-NLH-20 if Board approval of this application is not received by a date acceptable to Hydro, does Hydro intend to file a revised application relating to 2014 Industrial Customer rates?
