

## Island Supply Notes For August 15, 2025

- A As of 0800 hours, March 30, 2025, Holyrood Unit 3 unavailable due to planned outage 130 MW (150 MW).
- B As of 0823 hours, March 31, 2025, Bay d'Espoir Unit 1 unavailable due to planned outage (76.5 MW).
- C As of 0823 hours, March 31, 2025, Bay d'Espoir Unit 2 unavailable due to planned outage (76.5 MW).
- As of 0800 hours, May 04, 2025, Holyrood Unit 1 unavailable due to planned outage (170 MW).
- As of 0800 hours, June 08, 2025, Holyrood Unit 2 unavailable due to planned outage 115 MW (170 MW).
- As of 1400 hours, June 29, 2025, St. Anthony Diesel Plant available at 7.7 MW due to forced derating (9.7 MW).
- As of 0926 hours, July 21, 2025, Cat Arm Unit 2 unavailable due to planned outage (67 MW).
- **H** As of 0549 hours, July 24, 2025, Cat Arm Unit 1 unavailable due to planned outage (67 MW).
- As of 0000 hours, July 31, 2025, Hardwoods Gas Turbine unavailable due to forced extension to planned outage (50 MW).

#### Island Supply Notes For August 16, 2025

otes: 1. Generation outages for running and corrective maintenance are included. These are not unusual for power system operations. They generally do not impact customer supply. Hydro schedules outages to system equipment whenever possible to coincide with periods when customer demands are low and sufficient supply reserves are available. However, from time to time equipment outages are necessary and reserves may be impacted.

- 3. Gross continuous unit output.
- 4. Gross output from all Island sources (including Note 3).
- 5. NLH Island Power Purchases include: ML Imports, Exploits Generation, Rattle Brook, Star Lake, Wind Generation and capacity assistance (when applicable).
- 6. Adjusted for interruptible load and the impact of voltage reduction when applicable.
- 7. Due to limitations inherent in the design of combustion turbines, the output of combustion turbines may be reduced in the event that ambient temperatures exceed the threshold required for full rated output. This threshold is dependent on the design of each turbine.

- 9. LIL Import sunk in the Island System. Actual LIL flows will be restricted by various system conditions including, but not limited to, Island Load, ML Exports and Avalon Unit status.
