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(Liberty December 17, 2014 Report to Board on Supply Issues and Power 1 Q: 2 Outages Review Island Interconnected System addressing Newfoundland and 3 Labrador Hydro) Discussion on page 45 relates to the consistency of Hydro's reliability metrics with CEA Bulk Electricity System guidelines. Is it also 4 important to consider the impact of outages on production/market costs? For 5 6 example, a transmission outage may lead to dispatch of high-cost Holyrood 7 TGS production when low-cost hydropower would have been dispatched in 8 the absence of the outage. Does Liberty recommend that such impacts on 9 production costs be taken into consideration when assessing transmission 10 reliability performance?

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A. Hydro should consider the change in economics that result from changes in dispatch due to the loss of transmission facilities.
