1 Q. In reference to section 2.3, page 9 of the Teshmont Report, please confirm that the 2 reason for using 2011-2013 average load shape was the timing of study, i.e. the 3 study was started in 2014. What is Hydro's expectation of the impact of 2014 and 2015 load shapes to the analysis in the report? 4 5 6 7 A. The reason for using 2011-2013 average load shape was the timing of study as it 8 was initiated in 2014. It is noted that the Teshmont study involves a relative comparison of the pre-HVdc scenario to the post-HVdc scenario. As the same load 9 10 shape was used to assess both cases, slight variations that would arise from using updated data from 2015 or 2016 would not have a material impact on this relative 11 12 reliability comparison.
