1	Q.	Please explain why the Holyrood de-rates extend to emergency situations.

4	A.	The Holyrood de-rates extend to emergency power system situations as well as
5		normal operation to minimize the risk and consequence of forced outages and
6		further de-ratings due to possible tube failures. The consequence of a boiler tube
7		failure may be a loss of generation from Holyrood. In an emergency power
8		situation, maintaining generation from Holyrood could be critical.
