5 6	A.	The Inter-Utility System Reliability Committee (the "Committee") was established in
7		December 1999 with the objective of improving service to customers served by the Island Interconnected System. Key objectives of the Committee are to reduce outages arising
8		from under-frequency load shedding, set reliability targets, and initiate and monitor
9		activities to reduce the frequency and duration of outages on the Island Interconnected
10		System.
11		
12		In May 2013, the Committee broadened its scope to include transmission and distribution
13		system planning oversight and was renamed the Inter-Utility System Planning and
14		Reliability Committee.
