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Q. Please provide information showing the nature and numbers of Newfoundland Power customers whose load can be moderated by voltage reduction.

A. Newfoundland Power has the ability to moderate load by reducing voltage to
approximately 186,000, or 73%, of its customers.¹ Voltage reduction is initiated at the
substation level and impacts all Newfoundland Power rate classifications in substations
with voltage control capabilities.

9 It is not practical or possible to moderate load by voltage reduction in some of the 10 Company's substations. This is due to (i) some substation transformers not being 11 equipped with on-load tap changers; (ii) voltage limitations associated with long rural 12 feeders; (iii) automation limitations on some substation transformers; and (iv) voltage 13 requirements of down-line generation plants.
